DOC Note:

Fields will once again be open on Monday, February 21st. Please remember to be courteous and NOT park in the Handicap Parking Spaces or the grass at Tower Park. The City has asked me to remind you that they will start ticketing people if it continues. There is more than enough parking space in the upper parking lot if you take the time to go there. Also please remember that you should NOT be dropping or picking your child up on the overpass to Tower Park. Please pull into a parking spot and allow your child to get out of the car and walk to training. Letting them jump out of the car and run through the parking lot is not safe and could lead to an injury.

I also would like to remind you that tryouts for 2011-2012 will be coming up in June this year. The exact dates and time are still being determined, but we look to hold them during the weeks of June 2- June 12. Tryout information and registration will be linked to the website near the start of May. Please do your best to register for tryouts prior to the actual tryout. As in every year your current child's coach is NOT guaranteed. The coaching staff is selected and changed at the discretion of the DOC. It is the belief of the DOC and coaching staff that players will benefit more by changing coaches every 2-3 years. In some cases this may happen more frequently due to coaches leaving or needing to take a break. In other cases we might need to leave a coach with a certain team longer. Whatever the case, please know that these decisions are made in the best interest of the club and players. These decisions are made solely by the DOC and are approved by the Executive Board. Once this decision has been made it is final and no changes will be made. These staff decisions will be posted on the website no later than one month prior to tryouts.

Girls College Night (February 13th): The Girls College Night was a huge success for both BWSC and TNFC. With close to 120 people in attendance, a panel of 5 coaches answered player and parent questions for 2 hours. College coaches from Vanderbilt, Middle Tennessee State University, Sewanee, Trevecca, and Lee University were in attendance and provided answers and guidance to the process involved in girls college recruiting. The success of the Boys College Night in the Fall and the Girls College Night this Winter has been huge and both clubs have committed to doing it again next year. Thank you to all who were in attendance.
